## WHITE WINES

**Puligny-Montrachet 'Le Trézin' Marc Colin, 2023, France** £150.00

A finely etched Puligny offering lifted notes of white flowers, lemon zest and crushed limestone. Precise and elegant on the palate, its citrus and pear-skin layers glide into a long, saline, mineral finish.

**Meursault Clos du Cromin Domaine Patrick Javillier, 2023, France** £140.00

From Meursault's warm, clay-rich Clos du Cromin, this wine marries generous texture with vibrant acidity. Its racy precision unfolds into a slow, luxurious finish of remarkable poise and depth.

**Alberico Bianco Tenuta Principe Alberico, 2017, Lazio, Italy** £120.00

A complex and elegant Sémillon from volcanic soils in Lazio, glowing with a bright golden hue. The nose reveals ripe yellow fruit, white peach, apricot tart, orange blossom and beeswax, with mineral and smoky undertones. Full-bodied and balanced on the palate, it offers a soft, almost creamy texture lifted by vibrant acidity and marked minerality. The finish is long and persistent, leaving refined notes of stone, wax and white almond.

## RED WINES

**Chateau Angludet Margaux, 2021, France** £105.00

An elegant, medium-bodied Margaux with fresh red and black fruits, gentle spice, and floral nuance. Aging split between oak and clay amphorae brings purity of fruit and refined, silky tannins.

**Gevrey-Chambertin 'Les Crais' 2022 Jean-Michel Guillon, 2021, France** £155.00

Seductively dark-fruited, with aromas of black cherry, violets and a touch of mocha leading into a plush yet structured palate of ripe raspberry, forest floor and gentle spice. Silky tannins and the freshness of the 2021 vintage shape a long, refined and beautifully balanced finish.

**Chateau Batailley 2017 Pauillac, 2017, Bordeaux, France** £135.00

Internationally renowned critic James Suckling consistently praises Château Batailley 2017, noting its classic structure and aromas of black fruit, tobacco and dark chocolate. A serious, finely crafted Pauillac with beautiful, elegant tannins and impressive depth.

## MARCHESE ANTINORI

**Cervaro della Sala, 2023, Castello della Sala, Italy** £159.00

Antinori's flagship white from Umbria. This exquisite Chardonnay blend reveals delicate aromas of acacia blossoms, bergamot, and hints of buttered bread, wrapped in a refined, silky palate with vibrant freshness and savoury complexity. Perfect for special moments and pairing beautifully with seafood, poultry, or creamy dishes. Award winning and critically acclaimed.

**Tignanello, 2022, Tenuta Tignanello, Italy** £225.00

From the prestigious Tenuta Tignanello estate, this iconic Super Tuscan scored 97 points by James Suckling and 95 by Robert Parker. Intensely aromatic with cherry, wild berries, violet, and spice. Silky tannins, layered palate, perfect with game, red meats, and aged cheeses.

# WHITE WINES

## AUSTRALIA

**Adam, Who? Riesling, 2023, Eden Valley, South Australia** £39.50  
Aromatic nose of white peach and citrus blossom. Ripe pear and honeydew melon give way to a lingering, refreshing orchard fruit finish, with underlying slatey minerality. An expert balance between sweet fruit flavours and lemon/lime acidity.

## ENGLAND

**Bacchus Dry, Furleigh Estate, 2023, Bridport, Dorset** £52.00  
A stunning wine from on our doorstep delights with tropical notes especially pineapple, crisp and dry leaving a lingering finish that puts a smile on your face, a beautiful match with Dorset oysters.

## FRANCE

**Mon Roc Vermentino/Colombard, 2023, France** £31.00  
This lively blend is the perfect choice. Aromas of white fruits, including peach, citrus, and grapefruit, are enhanced by a hint of peony, inviting the senses. The palate follows with a crisp, fruity burst of lemon, grapefruit, and pear, balanced by subtle notes of white peach and fresh herbs. With vibrant acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.

**Bruno Andreu Chardonnay 2024, Languedoc, France** £34.00  
Yellow and shiny hue with golden reflections. Nice clearness. White peach aromas with white acacia flowers. Elegant mouth of hazelnut, almonds, citrus and brioche notes. Long finish with a nice freshness.

**Picpoul, L'Ormarine Selection, Picpoul Pinet, 2023, Languedoc, France** £37.00  
Citrusy southern French white wine made from Picpoul grape, soft and exotic peach flavours with a zingy finish.

**Muscadet sur lie, Jean Francois, 2022, Loire, France** £39.50  
Delicious creamy and fresh, this Muscadet is brilliant and a perfect match with oysters or with any fish where you'll need a squeeze of fresh lemon.

**Pouilly Fume, Corty, 2022, Loire, France** £52.50  
Subtle aromas of freshly cut grass, pears and apples, lovely citrus and fennel notes, this is a wonderful match with our mussels or pasta based dishes.

**Pouilly Fuisse, Carrette, 2023, Burgogne, France** £63.00  
From the oldest most prestigious appellations in Macon, this is from a tiny estate of 1 hectare and is one of the finest chardonnays that money can buy, classically structured with ripe fruits, mineral acidity, a fine match for any seafood especially lobster.

**Sancerre, 2024, Domaine la Barbotaine, France** £63.00  
A growers Sancerre. Piercing aromas of grapefruit on a palate of fresh cut grass. This dry and fruity white wine has a beautiful light yellow colour with brilliant reflections. It is full of finesse and complexity with delicate mineral touches.

**Chablis, Domaine Daniel Séguinot, 1er Cru, 2023, Burgundy, France** £79.00  
Premier Cru Chablis with a beguiling fresh hit of white nectarine and a crackle of citrus and minerality on the palate, the finish is clean, with pleasing steely acidity pairing perfectly with fish.

## HUNGARY

**Dry Tokaji, Béres Furmint, 2019, Tokaji, Hungary** £41.50

A delightful wine with deep apricot and orange notes, a little spicy with a pronounced texture and a notable long finish. One of my favourite drops this year.

## ITALY

**Doppio Passo Grillo 2023, Sicily, Italy** £37.50

An interesting alternative to Pinot Grigio or even New World Rhône varieties. Fresh, but with lovely complex structure. Made from the native Grillo grape, it offers ripe citrus, tropical fruit and a hint of almond, all wrapped in a crisp, refreshing finish.

**Gavi di Gavi, Antonio e Raimondo, 2023, Piedmont, Italy** £41.50

Gavi, nestled snugly in the Southeastern corner of Piedmont in Northern Italy. Here, the Cortese grape flourishes on fossil-rich soils, which are ideal to produce white grapes. Fratelli Antonio e Raimondo's Gavi di Gavi is pretty and perfumed with notes of orchard fruit.

**Bramito Chardonnay 2023, Castello della Sala, Italy** £59.00

A fresher, more approachable sister to the iconic Cervaro della Sala, from younger vines and aged in Cervaro's old oak. Bright pineapple and green apple with vanilla and toasted hazelnut, elegant and mineral-driven, evoking the finesse and vibrancy of a fine white Burgundy. Bramito is the perfect gateway to Cervaro's complexity.

## LEBANON

**Blanc de l'Observatoire, Château Ksara, 2023 Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** £44.50

Crafted by Lebanon's oldest winery, Château Ksara, founded in 1857, this elegant white wine blends Obeidy, Clairette, Muscat, and Sauvignon Blanc. The Obeidy and Clairette add structure, Muscat brings aromatic complexity with stone fruits and white flowers, while Sauvignon adds freshness and a crisp, lively finish, reflecting over 150 years of winemaking expertise.

## NEW ZEALAND

**Babich Classics Sauvignon Blanc, 2024, Marlborough, New Zealand** £44.50

Babich Classics Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc offers vibrant aromas of gooseberry, grapefruit, and lemon, with herbaceous and mineral notes. Medium-bodied and finishing fleshy and zesty, it showcases Marlborough's classic style. Produced by the sustainable, family-owned Babich Wines, it reflects over 100 years of winemaking experience.

## SPAIN

**Alba Vega Albariño 2023, Rias Baixas, Spain** £41.50

Aromas of stone fruit, honey, and floral notes mingling with wild herbs, sweeter mandarin skin and apple. Generous on the palate with hints of textural ripe gala melon, minerality, and a fresh citrus.

**Andaina Godello Adegas Galegas DO Monterre, 2023, Galicia, Spain** £44.50

Lively wine made from the upcoming and aromatic Godello grape -indigenous to the region- which displays a slightly weighty texture, refreshing minerality and aromas of wildflowers and chamomile.

## SOUTH AFRICA

**Chenin Blanc, Myburgh Bros, 2023, Paarl, South Africa** £44.50

Aromas of ripe apples and hints of peach. The palate is rich, with notes of honey and tropical fruit. There is a minerality and steely quality to the wine which gives a long finish.

## RED WINES

### AMERICAS

**Licanten Malbec, Idahue Estate La Ronciere, 2021, Chile, Argentina** £42.50

A complex aromatic profile with notes of black pepper, cherry, blackberry, dried plum, and cocoa. The wine is made from a majority of Malbec grapes with small additions of Merlot and Cabernet Franc leaving a silky mouth feel.

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Fossil Point, 2022, Paso Robles, USA** £55.00

Dense and dark, with fruit character of black-currant, dried plum and cocoa. French oak and sandalwood tones frame the tannins which suggest carob and walnut. Delicious and rich, but with enough balance to be well-suited at the table.

### FRANCE

**Cote Du Rhone, 2023, Rhone, France** £39.50

Immediately impressive, this wine reveals its class from the start. Brambly fruit underpinned by subtle oaky nuances, lovely, sweet spice - warm star anise with a touch of cinnamon. This classic Côtes du Rhône Villages is enriched with specially selected parcels from Séguret and Sablet villages.

**Pinot Noir Pays d'Oc, Badet Clément, 2023, Languedoc, France** £41.50

Crafted by winemakers with Burgundian heritage and expertise, this Pinot Noir is a testament to elegance and finesse. Bursting with bright cherry and berry fruit, it is medium bodied with supple tannins and a balanced finish. Gentle spice notes, subtle earthy undertones, and a delicate touch of oak add depth and complexity

**Fleurie La Madone Domaine Lathuiliere Gravallon, 2023, Beaujolais, France** £52.00

Lathuilière aim to strike a balance between the old and the new, with wines that respect the traditions of their ancestors but have one foot firmly in the present. this Fleurie displays sweet red gamay fruit, but also an impressive finesse and body drawn from its pink granite soils.

**Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, Château Vieille Tour La Rose, 2022, Bordeaux, France** £73.00

A classic Saint-Émilion Grand Cru showcasing centuries of winemaking tradition. This refined Bordeaux blend offers aromas of blackberries, dark cherries, and plums, layered with cedar, tobacco, and violet. The palate is smooth and balanced, featuring velvety tannins, rich dark fruit, mocha, and a touch of toasted oak on the elegant finish.

**Pomerol, Chateau La Grave, Trigant de Boisset, 2017 Pomerol, France** £94.50

One of the great, gravel soiled Pomerols. The nose offers hints of strawberry and damson whilst the palate has lovely balance, a silky structure with powder-fine tannins, freshness, purity and length.

### ITALY

**Primitivo, Mucchietto, IGT del Salento, 2023 Puglia, Italy** £41.50

The best Primitivo money can buy, a nose full of fresh red cherries, the palate is crammed with juicy plums, cinnamon and vanilla, with dark chocolate. Velvety tannins.

**Montipagano Montepulciano, Umani Ronchi Organic, 2023, Abruzzo, Italy** £44.50

Made from organic and sustainable vineyards in Abruzzo, presents fresh red berry aromas, herbal nuances, and subtle oak spice. The medium-bodied palate features elegant tannins, vibrant acidity, and flavors of dark fruits

**Barolo, 2019 Piemonte, Italy** £73.00

A complex nose combining plum, mulberry, ripe strawberry and brown spice with delicate floral and violet notes. Tannins are firm and pleasingly supported with plump fruit and a rounded texture, giving a good lengthy finish.

**Marchese Antinori Pèppoli Chianti Classico, 2024, Tenuta Tignanello, Italy** £55.00

From the heart of Chianti Classico, crafted by the Antinori family. Bright cherry and wild berry aromas layered with subtle floral notes, sweet spice and a touch of oak. Fresh and poised on the palate, with fine tannins, lively acidity and a clean, savoury finish that's both refined and effortlessly drinkable.

## ROMANIA

**Merlot, Pasari, 2023, Recas Cramele, Romania**

£31.00

Made from plump Merlot grapes which create this amazingly soft, sumptuous red is light enough to enjoy with a variety of fish and our local meat selection, drinks far better than its price tag.

## SPAIN

**Promesa Rioja Reserva, 2018, Rioja, Spain**

£52.00

Promesa Rioja embodies the tradition and craftsmanship of Spain's most celebrated wine region. Aged for five years, this delicious velvety Rioja is now showing its sophisticated savoury side, with rich berry fruit and a subtle oak influence

# ROSE WINES

## FRANCE

**Château de Berne, 2023, Provence, France**

£47.50

A fresh and very expressive rosé, packed with aromas and flavours of grapefruit, peach and ripe red fruit. On the palate these flavours continue along with a touch of mango and a refreshing citrus finish.

**Ultimate Rose, 2023, Provence France**

£58.00

Layers of raspberry and strawberry in the nose lead to a fruity, yet spicy palate. A fresh wine with great acidity for food pairing, but roundness to enjoy on its own. If you only have one bottle to bring – this is the ultimate wine for any occasion.

**Sancerre Rose Domaine Tissier, 2023, Loire, France**

£62.50

The finest Sancerre rose available, a rare find with small production, beautiful pink colour with succulent wild strawberries and a refreshing acidity.

## GREECE

**Theone Moschofilero Rosé, Kintonis, 2023, Peloponnese, Greece**

£36.50

Pale salmon pink, it offers aromas of Turkish Delight, rose petals, and lemon zest. The medium-bodied palate features vibrant grapefruit and lemon blossom flavours, with refreshing acidity and a soft, dry finish

## ITALY

**Antinori Calafuria Rosé 2024, Puglia, Italy**

£50.00

From the historic Antinori family, winemakers for over 600 years, this elegant rosé is made from Negroamaro grown along Puglia's sun-soaked Adriatic coast. Pale, refreshing and delicately perfumed with wild strawberry and citrus, it's the perfect taste of an Italian summer by the sea. Italy's answer to Provence.

## LEBANON

**Château Ksara "Sunset" Rosé, 2024 Bekaa Valley, Lebanon**

£40.00

From Lebanon's oldest and most celebrated winery, founded by Jesuit monks in 1857. Made from Cabernet Franc and Syrah, grown in the high-altitude Bekaa Valley. This vibrant rosé is fresh, juicy and fruit-driven, with notes of raspberry and redcurrant. A distinctive, characterful rosé from one of the world's oldest wine regions.

# SPARKLING WINES AND CHAMPAGNES

## ENGLAND

**Engelmann Cuvee**, English Oak Vineyard, 2022, Poole, England £10.50 (125ml) £59.50  
Crafted in the traditional Champagne method, Engelmann bursts onto your table and onto your palate. Intensely floral, fresh citrus notes demand attention on the nose, dancing into vibrant and zingy, pink grapefruit, gooseberry and a hint of green apple and pear on the palate.

**Chinkapin Rose**, 2022, English Oak Vineyard, Poole, England £11.00 (125ml) £62.50  
Salmon pink in colour, on the nose discover early hints of intense red berry fruits that will delight on the palate, underlined with a wickedly addictive orange peel

**San Gabriel**, 2019, English Oak Vineyard, Poole, England £11.50 (125ml) £65.00  
This wine offers a pure chardonnay blend ice white in colour, elegantly simple fresh citrus notes demand attention on the nose, slipping effortlessly into a delicious lemon sherbet on the palate.

## FRANCE

**Guy de Chassey Grand Cru Champagne** Champagne France £12.50 (125ml) £68.00  
Finely structured blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay has a bit of everything: zesty apple and citrus fruit, balanced by richer, toasted brioche flavours and refined bubbles. A classic Grand Cru Champagne.

**Drappier Carte d'Or Brut NV** Champagne, France £78.50  
Family-owned since 1808, Drappier are pioneers of Pinot Noir and masters of purity. Carte d'Or shimmers with golden fruit, brioche and finesse – Champagne as the French drink it: authentic, elegant and quietly luxurious.

**Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV**, Champagne, France £94.50  
Well known for both its full-bodied and consistent style, with aromas and flavours of baked apple, biscuit and brioche. A black grape dominated blend, using 50% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay. A blend of over 50 crus, mostly Premier and Grand Cru, with over 25% reserve wines.

**Bollinger Special Cuvée NV**, Champagne, France £99.50  
Famously firm and tightly knit, with a backbone of steely acidity, showing a fine, creamy texture that imparts an overall sense of finesse.

**Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé**, Champagne, France £130.00  
Rich, elegant and complex, with fresh citrus and red berry character, and soft creamy texture. Unquestionably the brand leader in this category, it is made, unusually, with 100% Pinot Noir grapes sourced from Grand Cru villages.

**Drappier Grande Sèndrée 2015**, Champagne, France £160.00  
From a single historic vineyard reborn from ashes, this prestige cuvée blends Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with sublime balance. Part aged beneath the sea, it reveals layers of honey, hazelnut and spice – Champagne craftsmanship at its most romantic.

**Dom Pérignon Brut, Vintage 2013**, Champagne, France £275.00  
Named after the Benedictine Monk Dom Pierre Perignon, this prestigious and legendary Champagne is a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir and aged for a minimum of 7 years on its lees. The result is a complex and elegant Champagne, with candied peel, nectarine and toasted brioche with fine and delicate bubbles.

## ITALY

**Midas Prosecco D.O.C**, Friuli, Italy £9.50 (125ml) £42.00  
Born in Bournemouth, produced in Friuli. Fresh and fruity bouquet, hints of apple, floral wisteria, and notes of crusty bread. A fine persistent mousse. Single estate.
